2017 KTM JUNIOR SUPERCROSS CHALLENGE



KJSC 2017 OFFICIAL RULES »

1. Child must be age seven (7) or eight (8) years old on the day of the selected KTM Junior Supercross Challenge event. Proof of age is required.
2. Due to the technical nature of the event and difficult obstacles, KTM Australia, requires that all applicants have at least one year of competition experience. Riders must submit a résumé documenting this information along with application to qualify for entry.
3. KTM Australia require the riders latest report card and or a letter from the rider's teacher. Academic participation and achievement will be part of the determining factor whether a rider qualifies for the event or not.
4. Riders must be able to pick up the motorcycle without assistance if fallen and be familiar with the starting procedure of the motorcycle as they will be unattended once on the race track.
5. Riders must hold a current Motorcycling Australia license to take part in this event.
6. All Motorcycling Australia competition and conduct rules apply to the KTM Junior Supercross Challenge.
7. Rider/family is responsible for travel to and from the event and any related expenses.
8. Rider must provide all safety equipment as required by Motorcycling Australia (helmet, boots, chest protector, kidney belt, goggles, etc.)
9. There is no application fee, however if selected, all participants must pay an entry fee of \$150.00 to KTM Australia.
10. Applications must be completed in full and all supplemental materials must accompany the application. Incomplete applications will be automatically deemed ineligible.
11. Completed applications must be received on or before the 6th October 2017. All participants will be chosen at random from the qualified applications received at that time.

12. Selected applicants will be notified 13th October 2017. The \$150.00 entry fee must be received 27th October 2017. If the entry fee is not received by this date, the position will be considered forfeit and KTM will select another rider to fill the vacant position.

13. In the event that a rider cannot fulfill his/her position to participate, KTM will reassign the position. You may not sell, transfer, or “scalp” your position to anyone else.

14. All video, audio, trademarks, or any other rights are the property of KTM Australia and AME Management.

15. Use of video cameras or equipment at any Supercross or KJSC event (on stadium floor or staging area) is strictly prohibited by AME Management. Cameras are allowed in the pits.

16. KJSC riders may not participate in any other riding activities during the race day.

17. KTM Australia reserves the right to add, delete, or change any rule at any time. All decisions made by KTM Australia are final.

18. KTM Australia and AME Management, reserves the right to determine who may or may not participate in the KJSC. While participants are determined through a drawing, there are exceptions.

19. There may be circumstances (such as weather) that may force AME management and KTM Australia to alter the schedule or cancel an event. AME Management and KTM Australia reserve the right to adjust the schedule as they see fit.
