WHAT THE RALLYE IS ALL ABOUT »

For the next chapter of ADVENTURE, the fourth annual KTM Australia Adventure Rallye trades the endless horizons and red dirt of the Outback for twisting turns, rugged mountains and spectacular coastlines in TASMANIA!

Open to Orange Adventure Riders with the following eligible KTM bikes: 640, 690, 950, 990, 1050, 1090, 1090R, 1190, 1190R, 1290 & 1290R models. The Rallye is tailored to suit a wide range of rider abilities, from those in their first years of Adventure riding up to seasoned Adventure pros.

For 2019, the Rallye returns to the five-day format with the focus on offering riders a truly memorable week exploring the stunning Apple Isle. Tasmania is a mecca of the best adventure roads we've seen - whether they be tar or dirt - that are set to make the KTM riders heart race. And in 2019 we are offering plenty of options for riders to choose their own adventure and difficulty of ride, with bitumen options offered in places for those that like to take it easy, or in case of really inclement weather. And for the hard-core nutters that ride their KTM Adventure bikes more like EXC's, we've got some enduro-style Breakout Routes on hand. It will be up to you each day to select how hard or easy you want to make your adventure.

Designed with the V-TWIN KTM Adventure range in mind, the route will vary from sweeping bitumen to tight twisty hairpins, flowing gravel roads and some fun on the odd beach run, plus slippery moss covered clay, rock gardens, creek crossings and just plain fun tracks! Combine this with the breathtaking scenery that is a Tassie trademark and we've got ourselves one epic Rallye.

The KTM Australia Adventure Rallye is about offering a great experience to our ORANGE adventure riders - and what better way to do that than by crossing the Bass Strait and enjoying 5-days exploring the best that Tassie has to offer on your KTM adventure bike. Bring old friends or make new ones, in the spirit of adventure riding, the Rallye is about getting back to the basics.

THE ROUTE »

Backing up from the Outback Run in 2018 was always going to be a challenge. So - where would we go? Let's replace the red dirt, open skies and pure unbridled adventure of the Outback with the green, lush, twisty turns of Tasmania. Nick Selleck is back on board as our Rallye Route Coordinator and when deciding on this location, he simply stated . . . *"Tasmania has the best adventure riding I have ever done!"* . . .

Pick a road, any road, in Tasmania and it's likely to be an awesome one for adventure motorcycling. So many twists and turns. Mountains to summit. Forests to forage in. Coastline to explore. The difficulty with Tassie is trying to fit it all in and not miss anything.

The 2019 KTM Australia Adventure Rallye Tasmania will incorporate many of the top "must see" adventure icons of the Apple Isle. You know the ones every rider comes back raving about; Cradle Mountain, Macquarie Harbour at Strahan, Queenstown, Jacobs Ladder, Western Explorer, Fatman Ferry over Pieman River, The Hazards at Freycinet Peninsula, Bay Of Fires.



Aside from the well-known landmarks what we can't wait to show you is the tucked away surprise tracks that you've never heard of. Along with Nick's experience of several tours in Tassie we've enlisted some local experts to dig into their knowledge and make sure we don't pass anything by.

We believe the real gold for adventure riding lies in the north-east of the state where we will spend the last couple of days. Whooped out sand tracks, rocky trails shared with mountain bikes, rich clay based tracks that are best avoided if wet. The north-east will give you a whole new love for Tasmania.

The goal for this years route is to offer a diverse option for riders, ensuring everyone can make their own adventure. Want to take it easy and enjoy the spectacular scenery and unique towns and areas of interest along the way? The Main Route will cater for riders who want a more relaxed day with less technically challenging tracks than we have seen in previous years.

Don't think for a second that we are going soft though! The Breakout options will have some serious riding, with our first ever 4 Chili options for the truly brave.

With the route kicking off the adventure at the iconic Cradle Mountain, before heading down to Strahan, Hobart, Swansea and St Helens before finishing in Launceston means riders have easy access back to the Ferry or the airport for transport home. The diversity of the terrain, combined with the atmosphere and camaraderie of riding with like-minded KTM adventurers in one of the most beautiful parts of Australia . . . the 2019 KTM Australia Adventure Rallye is set to deliver!

NAVIGATION INFORMATION »

The Rallye is tailored to suit a range of rider abilities, from those starting out in their first year or two of adventure riding, to seasoned Adventure pros. In order to cater for this variety of levels, each day's course can be traversed in your own time, at your own pace, with two route options available daily - the Main Route and Breakout Routes.

Lead riders depart before the group each morning to ensure the tracks are clear, plus sweep riders bring up the tail end of the pack to assist with any issues that may arise throughout the day. A detailed route sheet for each day will be supplied at the nightly rider briefings, however for riders the main source of navigation comes in the form of GPS files, supplied prior to the Rallye. Therefore it is required that riders have a GPS unit to navigate for the event.

Riders are free to depart each morning between 8.00-9.30am, in their own time and on their own agenda. There will be Points of Interest on each days route sheet, so riders can stop and enjoy these along the way, as well as suggested breakfast and lunch stops.

RALLYE SUPPORT »

LUGGAGE SUPPORT. Every rider will be allowed to place one bag (roll-bag or pack) in the KTM Luggage Truck, which will be carried for them between each destination.

TECH SUPPORT. We will have KTM Australia mechanics available to assist with any issues that may arise along the way that you cannot fix yourselves. This tech service will be limited to issues that arise as a result of the Rallye, not assistance with pre-existing issues. Therefore a pre-event Tech Check at your local KTM dealership will be necessary for all Registered Rallye Riders.

TYRE SUPPORT. We will have a Tyre Support available from the amazing Overlanders crew. For those who wish to get a new tyre or tyres fitted before the Rallye or during the Rallye. Pre-bookings are essential!

GENUINE PARTS SUPPORT. All riders are advised to bring spare parts along, however due to unforeseen circumstances that may arise when adventure riding, we will have Genuine KTM Spare Parts available for riders to purchase throughout the Rallye.

MEDIC SUPPORT. With the assistance of the outstanding crew from RaceSafe Australia, medical support personal will be on hand to assist throughout the event. The medical support will be available each day through multiple channels: sweep rider, 4WD backup vehicle and nightly at the Bivouac.

More information on all the provided support will be given to those who register for the event in the form of a REGISTERED RIDER DOSSIER.

ACCOMMODATION & DINNERS »

It will be up to you, the rider, to book your preferred overnight accommodation. Once you register, you will receive a **REGISTERED RIDER DOSSIER: ACCOMMODATION** which will outline all the suggested accommodation venues and where the nightly Riders Briefing and Dinners will take place, which we call the "Bivouac". Our overnight destinations might be a little more accommodating than the actual Bivouac at the Dakar though!

BIVOUAC. Each night we will have one particular location as the Bivouac. This is where your luggage will be available to collect each afternoon, as well as the dinner destination and the location of the nightly riders briefing and social revelry. The suggested accommodation locations are all within either walking distance or a short ride from the Bivouac every night.

DINNERS. Are included in the Rallye price every night! From the Welcome Dinner on the first night until the final Wrap-Up Dinner. So after a long day on the bike, you don't need to worry about having to hunt down some chow - we've got it sorted for you.



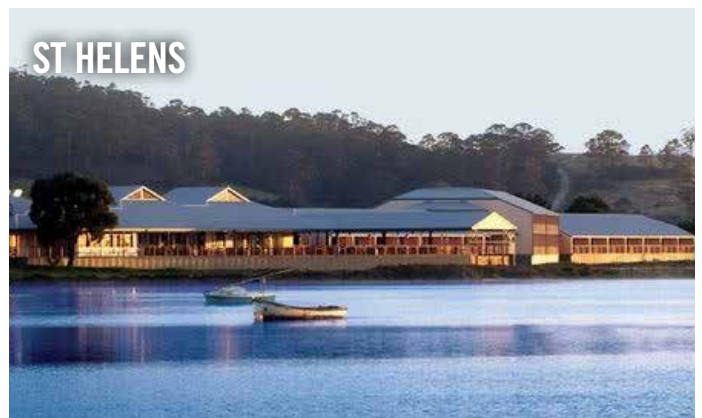

REGISTRATION PROCESS »

Authorised KTM Dealerships in Australia will be receiving Dealer Priority Registration: meaning they receive the registration link before it is open to the public. Therefore, touch base with your local KTM Dealership and get your name and email on their Adventure database to ensure you get this Dealer Priority Registration information!

Allocation of Rallye spots will be based on the following criteria: Two-Thirds for Dealer Priority Registration and One-Third for Public Registration. We hope you can be a part of the fourth annual KTM Australia Adventure Rallye: Tasmania!
